Responsibilities

- Oversee all aspects of operations including order entry, medication dispensing processes, timely delivery, reporting, invoicing, ordering, and inventory management to ensure accuracy.
- Dispensing prescription drugs to patients and offering their expertise on how to safely use prescribed medicines.
